Two days leather product making training organized in Commerce & Industries Department, Government of Sikkim in association with Central Leather Research Institute (CLRI), Government of India, Chennai on leather and Non leather product making at Conference Hall of Commerce & Industries Department, Udyog Bhawan, Tadong on 22-11-2022 & 23-11-2022.

The training programme was chaired by Hon'ble Advisor, Commerce & Industries Department Shri Kado Tshering Bhutia and attended by Dr. Suresh Kumar, Senior Scientist and his team from CLRI, Director, MSME, Additional Secretary and officials from Commerce & Industries Department. Around 25 local entrepreneurs from SHGs, MPCs and aspiring entrepreneurs attended the training programme.

He further informed that financial assistance availed from Skilled Youth Startup Scheme to set up their enterprises after the training.



Director, MSME welcomed the Chief Guest and resource persons from CLRI and explained about the training programme planned. He informed the participants that after this inception training longer training programmes also planned in near future for complete handholding of local entrepreneurs.

Additional Secretary, C&I Department appealed to the entrepreneur to take full advantage of the training programme, further stated that the Department is ready to help local entrepreneurs in setting up their business in leather product making.
